The Bluebonnet Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors will hold a Special Called Meeting and Public Hearing on Wednesday, March 11, 2009 in the Waller County Road and Bridge Office located at 775 Business 290 East, Hempstead, Texas. The public hearing and Board meeting will commence at 1:00 p.m. The meeting and public hearing concern:

- 1. Call to Order
- 2. Public Hearing. The Public Hearing will be conducted in accordance with Section 14 of the District Rules. The General Manager will recommend to the Presiding Officer a Public Hearing not to exceed 4 hours with time limits as follows: Spring Preserve Water Company LLC 1.5 hours; Protesting Parties (to be determined at the Public Hearing) 1.5 Hours; and General Manager/District Consultants 1 hour. The Public Hearing concerns the request from Spring Preserve Water Company LLC for and the protests of the following:
- a. Non-Exempt Well Development Application filed by Spring Preserve Water Company LLC (Applicant) whose address is c/o New Waverly Sound Investments, LLC; P.O. Box 502, Hockley, TX 77447 for a proposed non-exempt public water supply well to be generally located six miles northeast of Waller, TX on Kickapoo Road and Hegar Parkway in the Shubal Marsh Survey, Abstract No. 217. The volume of water proposed to be produced from this well is 137.2174 acre-feet (44,712,500 gallons) per year. The water produced from this well is proposed for use to serve the Kickapoo Preserve subdivision, which is adjacent to the proposed well site. - b. Well Operating Permit Application filed by Spring Preserve Water Company LLC whose address is c/o New Waverly Sound Investments, LLC; P.O. Box 502, Hockley, TX 77447 for a proposed non-exempt public water supply well to be generally located six miles

northeast of Waller, TX on Kickapoo Road Hegar Parkway in the Shubal Marsh Survey, Abstract No. 217. The volume of water proposed to be produced from this well is 44,712,500 gallons per year. The water produced from this well is proposed for use to serve the Kickapoo Preserve subdivision, which is adjacent to the proposed well site. The Application is available for inspection and review during business hours at the District Offices located at 303 East Washington Avenue, Suite D, Navasota Texas by contacting in advance Mr. Lloyd Behm, General Manager 936-825-7303.
