The Bluebonnet Groundwater Conservation District (BGCD) will hold a public hearing on the proposed revisions to BGCD Rules (Rules). The Board of Directors (Board) will consider revising the Rules at the Board meeting following the public hearing. The revisions considered encompass statute changes to Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code (Chapter 36) effective from the 85<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session which include definitions, joint planning representatives, registration and permitting, application requirements for non-exempt wells, and general language clean up revisions.

BGCD uses these Rules as a guide in the exercise of the powers conferred by law and in the accomplishment of the purposes Chapter 36 and Chapter 8825 Texas Special District Local Laws Code. BGCD is committed to well owners, landowners, residents and the conservation, preservation, and protection of the groundwater resources in our area.
