The Bluebonnet Groundwater Conservation District (BGCD) will hold a public hearing on the revisions to the District Rules. The Board of Directors will consider revising the Rules at the Board meeting following the public hearing. The revisions considered encompass statute changes to Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code effective from the 84<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session which include definitions, aquifer storage and recovery wells and projects, time for action on permits, maximum allowable production, Board action on permits, amendments to operating permits, hearing procedures, proposal for decision, notice and hearing in an appeal of desired future conditions; judicial appeal of desired future conditions, rulemaking proceedings, and general language clean up revisions.

The District uses these Rules as a guide in the exercise of the powers conferred by law and in the accomplishment of the purposes of the District Act. The District is committed to well owners, landowners, residents and the conservation, preservation, and protection of the groundwater resources in our area.
